Annual renewal for the Yoggie Gatekeeper Personal™ model is \$29.90 a year, which makes the entire offering favorably comparable with software-only security suites on the market, which offer far less protection than the Yoggie Gatekeeper Personal™.

The Yoggie Gatekeeper SOHO™, with its 520 MHz CPU and 128MB memory, is normally priced at \$249 but for a limited introductory period, is available for \$199 which includes a one year subscription for all the licensed software integrated in the security appliance, licenses to protect up to 5 computers and a Power adaptor. Annual renewal for the Yoggie Gatekeeper SOHO™ model is \$39.90 a year, which makes the entire offering favorably comparable with 5 copies of software-only security suites on the market, which offer far less protection than the Yoggie Gatekeeper Personal™.
